1	Add -s to form the plural of most nouns.	student chief picture	student s chief s picture s
2	Add -es to form the plural of nouns that end in ss , ch , sh , and x . (This ending adds another syllable.)	class watch dish box	class es watch es dish es box es
3	Add - <i>es</i> to form the plural of nouns that end in <i>o</i> preceded by a consonant. EXCEPTION: Add - <i>s</i> to plural nouns ending in <i>o</i> that refer to music.	potato piano soprano	potato es piano s soprano s
4	Add -s to form the plural of nouns that end in o preceded by a vowel.	radio	radio s
5	To form the plural of words that end in a consonant + y , change the y to i and add -es .	dictionary fly	dictionar ies fl ies
6	To form the plural of words that end in a vowel + y , add -s .	boy day	boy s day s
7	To form the plural of certain nouns that end in f or fe , change the f to v and add -es .	half loaf knife wife	hal ves loa ves kni ves w ives
8	Some plural nouns are irregular .	woman child person mother-in-law man foot tooth	women children people mothers-in-law men feet teeth
9	Some nouns do not have a singular form .	(eye) glasses clothes pants scissors	
10	Some plural nouns are the same as the singular noun.	Chinese fish sheep	Chinese fish sheep
